Westwood Heights School District will again participate in the 105/105C State Schools of Choice program accepting Kindergarten – 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Unlimited enrollment K-8<sup>th</sup>, Limited enrollment 9 – 12<sup>th</sup>. Applications are available online from July 10, 2023 – August 18, 2023 for fall 2023. Access the district website at [www.hamadyhawks.net](http://www.hamadyhawks.net). The deadline to submit applications is Friday, August 18, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.

Important Note to Parents: Parents must provide the previous two years of behavior for students applying for grades 1<sup>st</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>, one year of behavior for students who have completed one year of school and not required for students entering kindergarten for the first time. A district representative must sign the behavior. A statement on district letterhead or a blank behavior report from your district's student information system must be provided to verify students with no behavior history to report. All behavior from all schools attended must be submitted with the application. Applications will be considered incomplete if behavior is not submitted from all schools attended in the two-year period.

Transcript is required for all students applying for 9<sup>th</sup> grade and higher to verify credit status. Report Card is required for all students applying for 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> to verify grade placement.

Any new incoming student must apply (including siblings). If you have a student currently attending under the 105/105c and would like the sibling to attend Westwood Heights Schools, you must apply for the sibling. Siblings are not automatically accepted for enrollment.

### **TRANSPORTATION IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT/GUARDIAN.**

If accepted for enrollment under section 105/105c Schools of Choice program, students do not need a release from their resident district and can remain in the district through graduation with continuous enrollment pending any major behavior issues.
